
Righteousness & Sakvation: The Order Emingeris Capable

Thanksgiving and sound of a melody.



Look to Abraham's Example

- * YaHWeH called and Abraham answered.
- * Because he obeyed, YaHWeH blessed Abraham.
- * Zion has not been forgotten.
- * Zion will be blessed in a similar way that YaHWeH blessed Abraham.

Zion in thZionIin the OT

- Mountain of the LORD (2 Ki. 19:31, Ps. 2:6)
- * Jerusalem (2 Sam. 5:7, 1 Ki. 8:1)
- * Daughter of Zion (ref. to Jerusalem in Ps. 9:14)
- * Heaven (Ps. 9:11)



What then shall we say that Abraham, our forefather according to the flesh, has found? For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS." Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due. But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is credited as righteousness,

Romans 4:1-5

Beliefg=tRighteousness

- * Belief is ALWAYS followed by action.
- * Abraham believed YaHWeH was able to deliver the on the promises YaHWeH made him. Abraham's belief caused him to obey YaHWeH.
- * YaHWeH blessed Abraham because he did as he was told.

What AbWhat About Us?

- Belief is still followed by action.
- * If we believe God can and will grant us eternal life, we will obey Him.
- Obedience is not the same as "working our way to Heaven."
- Obedience is a reaction based on our faith and trust in God's power and grace.

And My arms will judge the peoples;


The coastlands will wait for Me,

- Israel and Judah both ignored YaHWeH.
- * YaHWeH had given a law that needed to be followed.
- * His law was founded upon justice.
- Righteousness and salvation would come from YaHWeH.



What AbWhat About Us?

- We need to pay attention to what God says and does. FOCUS!
- God has given us commands to follow.
- Righteousness and salvation are only available through God's plan.

And the grub will eat them like wool.


But My righteousness will be forever,

Some Things Endure, Some Don't

- * The earth and everything in it will end.
- YaHWeH's Word will last forever.
- * YaHWeH's salvation will last forever.
- * His people do not need to fear other men but simply remain faithful to God.



If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay on earth; knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ. For He was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you who through Him are believers in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

- * The Father judges based on deeds.
- * Redemption came through the blood of Jesus.

What AbWhat About Us?

- * Our deeds reveal our heart.
- We should be so grateful for the cleansing we have received that we seek to do good deeds in God's Name.
- Our good deeds do not redeem us. Only Jesus can do that.
- There is no other word coming from God. The Bible is the complete revelation.



Rock Springs church of Christ grow in respect to salvation.

Baker Compact Bible Dictionary on Rahab

* Many scholars believe that
Rahab is identical to the
Canaanite Leviathan. In the OT
YaHWeH fights Rahab in the
process of ending chaos and
creating the world.

Later, Egypt is sometimes equated with the monster Rahab (Ps. 87:4; Isa. 30:7), although there is no historic relationship between the two.

Order Out of Chaos

- The Northern Kingdom was destroyed in 721 BC and Jerusalem would be destroyed in 586 BC.
- * Isaiah urges the people to turn back to YaHWeH.
- * He reminds them of YaHWeH's ability to bring order out of chaos.
- * God's people would return to Zion. He would not forget them or the covenant.



Mhat AbMhat About Us?

- * Sometimes it is necessary for God to discipline His people.
- No matter what is happening (or what injustice is being suffered) God is still in control.
- * God has ransomed His people.

 No matter what happens to us
 in this life, we have a home
 with Him waiting.
- * This home is a result of Jesus' death and resurrection.
