- The Messiah would fulfill the Old Covenant.
- Jesus was the blood sacrifice satisfying the Old Covenant.
- The New Covenant was based on the blood of Jesus.
- The New Covenant offers forgiveness to all mankind.

THE ARMY GENERAL RIDES

The reproach of exile is a burden on them."

A WARRIOR AMONG THEM

- Zephaniah prophesied during King Josiah's reign from 640 - 609 BC (Zeph. 1:1). His main message was Judah's punishment and the Coming of the Day of the Lord on the nations.
- YaHWeH's judgment on Judah would come to an end.
- YaHWeH would once again be among His people.
- YaHWeH would defend His people like a warrior.

PUNISHMENT THEN RESTORATION

- If we disobey, God will punish us.
- God's punishments are meant to lead us to repentance.
- He wants to restore us.

For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form, and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority; and in Him you were also circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, in the removal of the body of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ; having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.


Colossians 2:9-12

VICTORY PARADE


- God has made His people complete in Christ.
