

PROPHECYFULFILMENT

- The prophet was given the message but not necessarily given the understanding of how it was to be fulfilled (Hill and Walton 411, 1 Pet. 1:10-12).
- Prophecies sometimes were given in pictures and examples.
- Sometimes a prophecy has multiple fulfillments.

WAIT.WE'RE IN TROUBLE (JEREMIAH 30)

- Israel was going to be punished too.
- Israel's sins have fatally wounded them.
- Their supposed allies will abandon them.
- All of these things are a result of their sins. They caused this trouble.



JERENJEREMIAH431:1-14

"At that time," declares the LORD, "I will be the God of all the families of Israel, and they shall be My people" (Jeremiah 31:1).

- Survivors found grace (2).
- They're loved and drawn by lovingkindness (Hesed) (3).
- They'll be rebuilt, re-established, and ransomed (4-11).
- They'll be provided for in abundance (12-14).

RESTORATION & BLESSING

- YaHWeH would not remain angry forever.
- YaHWeH would restore Israel to their former relationship with Him.
 - A relationship with YaHWeH would be the thing to draw His people to Him.
- YaHWeH would ransom His people from Babylonian captivity and ultimately from sin.
 - All of this would happen on "just another day."

"Behold, days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will sow the house of Israel and the house of Judah with the seed of man and with the seed of beast. As I have watched over them to pluck up, to break down, to overthrow, to destroy and to bring disaster, so I will watch over them to build and to plant," declares the LORD.

- "In those days they will not say again,
 - 'The fathers have eaten sour grapes,
 - And the children's teeth are set on edge.'

But everyone will die for his own iniquity; each man who eats the sour grapes, his teeth will be set on edge."

NO MORENO MORE....

- The people were blaming everyone but themselves for their current situation (see Ezekiel 18:1-4).
- They were treating YaHWeH like the other gods of the nations around them.
- YaHWeH says that this attack on His character was going to stop among His people (see Exodus 34:6-7).
- There is a difference between guilt and consequences.

JUST ANOTHER DAY

- Terms of the covenant were going to change.
- The possible intimacy of the individual relationship with YaHWeH was going to change.
- Just like the Babylonian restoration would happen on a regular day, the covenant would as well.

SIMISAMILIARITIESDOLD/ NEW CNEWNGOVENANT

- People enter the covenant only in God's designated way.
- God is the One in charge.
- God is the One that must be obeyed.
- God's people are to look different than the "outsiders" in their behaviors.

For, on the one hand, there is a setting aside of a former commandment because of its weakness and uselessness (for the Law made nothing perfect), and on the other hand there is a bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God. And inasmuch as it was not without an oath (for they indeed became priests without an oath, but He with an oath through the One who said to Him,

"THE LORD HAS SWORN

AND WILL NOT CHANGE HIS MIND,

'YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER");

Hebrews 7:18-21

so much the more also Jesus has become the guarantee of a better covenant. The former priests, on the one hand, existed in greater numbers because they were prevented by death from continuing, but Jesus, on the other hand, because He continues forever, holds His priesthood permanently. Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
